Product Description:

Power Brite is specifically formulated for fiberglass and gel-coat surfaces.

It is the perfect one-step product for boats and RVs. It easily removes oxidation and chalky surfaces and creates a smooth, deep, finish.

It is best to use Power Brite with a high speed polisher. For non-oxidized surfaces, it can also be used with an orbital polisher.

Power Brite's abrasives will cut through oxidation with ease, then break down to polish the surface. It also contains a high concentration of waxes and resins. These ingredients fill in fiberglass' porous surface and protect it from salt water, pollution, UV damage, etc.

For fast cutting on heavy oxidation, use a wool pad. For medium oxidation, use a cutting foam pad and for polishing, use a light cut or finishing foam pad.

Power Brite is not recommended for painted surfaces such as automobiles or painted RVs. It is only recommended for Fiberglass and Gel-coat surfaces.

Directions:

By Machine:

1. Surface should be clean and cool to the touch
2. Set polisher to 1200 - 2000 rpm with a wool or foam pad depending on cut / polish you desire.
3. Apply a small amount of product to paint and spread over a 2' x 2' area. Try to keep pad flat at all times.
4. Buff evenly, using overlapping motions, until product is almost all gone.
5. Remove residue with a microfiber towel. Continue to next section.
